

# Dowsing & the Labyrinth



## A one-day workshop to celebrate World Labyrinth Day and International Dowsing Day

Celebrate International Dowsing Day and World Labyrinth Day with this fun workshop. Learn how the ancient art of dowsing and the ancient symbol of the labyrinth can help you connect with your inner self and enhance your intuitive skills.

Labyrinths are powerful transformational and healing tools – they differ from a maze in that they have only one path to the goal, so you don't have to think about where you are going, you simply follow the path. They can be used for meditation, prayer walks, problem solving and ceremony. As sacred spaces, they generate beneficial healing earth energies that you will discover using dowsing. During the workshop, we will construct and work with a temporary 7-circuit Classical labyrinth in the garden using dowsing to determine the best placement. You will also have the opportunity to experience the famous Traquair hedge maze - the largest in Scotland.

Our tutor is internationally-renowned dowser, geomancer and labyrinth creator Grahame Gardner, Past President of The British Society of Dowsers. Grahame has been working with and making labyrinths for many years, and is a wonderful guide to the mysteries of the Path. His recently discovered labyrinth dance '*Gardner's Double Appleton*' will be the exciting conclusion to this fun day.

Bring suitable outdoor clothes and footwear and dowsing tools if you have them. Bring your own lunch or eat in the Traquair restaurant.
